- Pray for the upcoming SASRA Spiritual Refreshment Conferences this month. Scripture Readers often 'give out' a lot in their ministries, which can be isolating and lonely. These events are an opportunity to 'care for the carers'. Please pray that they will be spiritually refreshed.
- Please pray for the highly significant case of Kristie Higgs, which will be heard in the Court of Appeal starting today. Kristie lost her job for posts on her private Facebook account raising widely-shared concerns about the content of some sex education materials used in primary schools. This case will set a precedent for the freedom of Christians to express their faith and for freedom of speech. Please pray for justice. Kristie is being supported by **Christian Concern**
- Please pray for the Association of Grace Baptist Churches South East (AGBCSE) twoday pastors' training residential happening over the next two days (3–4 October). Pray that it will be a blessing to the 20 or so men attending. Greg Gilbert will be teaching on preaching. AGBCSE's Annual Association Day is planned for this Saturday (5 October). Please pray that this will encourage all who attend. Speakers include Greg Gilbert, James Mildred, and Jonathan Worsley.
- Pray today for the True Freedom Trust conference taking place in Dublin tomorrow (5 October). Pray for Colin Creighton, who is speaking, and that those attending will grow in the love and knowledge of Christ through hearing his Word.
- 4 5 6 7 8 9 Pray for the Vinukonda Medical and Missionary Fellowship AGM, held at Little Hill Church, Wigston. Pray that the trustees and supporters will be encouraged and granted wisdom as they consider the mission's work.
- Please pray for the final preparations for the FIEC Leaders' Conference happening next month (4–6 November) as they finalise details and church leaders prepare to attend.
- Pray for a quick and successful resident visa application for the McCarter family to come from the USA, as Ethan prepares to become minister at Crosscollyer Church (part of the **Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Ireland).**
- Give thanks for the opportunity Ros Clarke, Associate Director of Church Society, had to speak at the North London Women's Convention this week (5 October). She spoke on the topic of 'Made by God: Body and Soul.'
- Give thanks for an encouraging start to the new ministry at Edinburgh North Church, where Stephen Ballingall was inducted on Saturday (5 October) as pastor. Edinburgh North is part of the Didasko Fellowship of Churches. They also look forward to the induction of Nathan Owens as minister of Gilcomston Church, Aberdeen, on Friday 1 November. Please pray for the leadership at Tron Church, Glasgow, particularly as one of the pastors, Phil Copeland, undergoes chemotherapy for serious cancer.
- Please pray for the **UFM Worldwide** 'Local Church Global Mission' event, held in partnership with Union Church, Sheffield, on Saturday (12 October). Pray that attendees will grow in passion and zeal for world mission.

- Please pray for the **Affinity** Social Issues Team, which met this week to discuss current cultural and social issues. They will now produce the Social Issues Bulletin, aiming to inform and equip Christians and churches on relevant matters.
- Please pray for Christian schools known to **The Christian Schools' Trust** as they face the imposition of VAT on school fees from January 2025. Pray that the government will listen to calls for a fairer system, especially for schools with lower fees, smaller pupil numbers, and who make significant sacrifices (teachers and parents).
- Please pray for the Faith in Later Life Church Champion Networking Events, held monthly. These gatherings allow those serving older people in churches or communities to share and pray together. Next month's event will focus on supporting bereaved people. Please pray for good attendance and that it will be helpful to all.
- Jonathan Thomas will give the annual Martyn Lloyd-Jones Memorial Lecture at London Seminary tomorrow (15 October) at 7:30 pm on 'Welsh Revivals'. Pray that many will attend and be inspired to pray for church revival. Also, pray for the London Seminary Trustees' meeting earlier in the day.
- 15 CARE asks for prayer that none of the MPs drawn in the Private Members' Bill ballot will introduce a bill on assisted suicide. Pray that the top seven MPs will focus on local issues, resisting pressure from pro-assisted suicide campaigners and No.10. The bills will be presented tomorrow (16 October).
- Give thanks that Lovewise has opportunities to present a biblical perspective on relationships at a Rock UK training event in Carlisle this week (17–18 October) and promote resources at the Answers in Genesis Mega Conference in Birmingham (31 October–2 November). Pray that young people and their parents will be equipped to honour God's design for relationships.
- Please pray for 100 MicroSD Cards, known as 'Mustard Seeds', being prepared by **100Fold** to be used for evangelism by a partner mission in Nigeria.
- Please pray for the **Association of Christian Teachers** as they refine and implement their new mentoring course, 'Faithful Foundations'. Pray that they will find mature Christians to serve as mentors and that a group of teachers will grow through applying biblical principles in the classroom.
- Join Solas in giving thanks to the Lord for many recent answers to prayer. Evangelism can be challenging, but recent blessings have been a great encouragement. Please pray for the production of online evangelistic and apologetic resources, that they will reach more non-Christians.
- Give thanks for a united church family at **Duke Street Church, Richmond**, and a smooth transition to life with their new Senior Minister, James Muldoon. Pray for wisdom as they seek God's leading in this next phase of church life and that many local people will be saved through their outreach.
- Praise God for a renewed emphasis on evangelism and a deepening spirituality in prayer among Evangelical Fellowship of Congregational Churches (EFCC) churches, resulting in wonderful fruit. Give thanks for new churches joining the EFCC.
- 22 Christian Medical Fellowship celebrates its 75th anniversary today. Give thanks for God's work through many years of ministry, and pray for Christian healthcare staff, many of whom are under tremendous strain and feeling at a crisis point.
- Please pray for the beginnings of a new Free Church of Scotland church plant in Glasgow's Merchant City. Pray that God will call those meant to join the core team and that they will have unity and passion for the gospel. Give thanks for the Centre for Rural Ministry, which launches next month. Pray for Rev Ivor MacDonald as he takes up the role of Director for Rural Ministry.
