Please pray that ReachAcross's newest missionary family will receive all the financial support they need to move overseas in February. The couple will serve primarily in taking the gospel to Muslims in the Balkans. Their ministry will focus on healthcare provision, youth work, church work, evangelism, and discipleship. $\frac{2}{3}$ As 2024 begins, join Wycliffe Bible Translators in praying for God's protection and provision as many translation teams aim to reach the finishing line of their translations this year, so that nothing stops people from accessing God's word. Please pray for much fruit from the Christmas Festival, Carol Services, and Christmas Day Service hosted by Trinity Road Chapel, Tooting, last month. Give thanks for the many Christmas services they also held in local care homes. Praise God for his financial provision to SASRA over 2024, and ask that this would continue over 2025 so that SASRA Scripture Readers can continue to proclaim Christ 'behind the wire' of Army and RAF bases. 5 The Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Ireland (EPCI) is holding a special day of prayer today (5 January) across all EPCI churches. Please pray particularly for the Lord to raise up more men for the ministry of the gospel. Please pray for **London Seminary** as they launch the first ever cohort of 'Relay', a new course helping church pastors train lay leaders for faithful and fruitful ministry. Pray also for the course run by Garry Williams this week for Master of Theology students, some travelling long distances to attend. Please pray that Little Hill Church, Wigston's Prayer Week (7–9 January) will set the pattern of dependent prayer for the year ahead. Please pray that the Christmas break will have been a time of blessing, rest, and renewal for all teachers who are part of The Christian Schools' Trust member schools, and that they return re-envisioned for what they are called to do. Annette* serves in Africa Inland Mission (AIM) Southern Region Office. Give thanks for the encouraging time she had with other AIM workers at the Johannesburg Africa-Based Orientation recently. Pray for her and the AIM Southern Region team as they prepare for significant organisational changes early this year. Ask God to provide visas for two new families joining the team and a more permanent home for Annette close to the Johannesburg office. (*Name changed for security reasons.) **100Fold** copies gospel and Bible teaching materials onto micro SD cards, which, through their many partners, are often distributed to hard-to-reach places. Praise God that 100Fold was able to distribute nearly 25,000 cards in 2024 and has recently received requests for an additional 15,000.

11	As schools return after the Christmas break, please pray for the Christians that Crossteach knows in schools (adults and young people). Pray that they will cling to God's trustworthy nature and that they will be effective 'lights in the darkness' in their families and school communities. Please also pray for Crossteach staff, that they would have been spiritually refreshed by the break and feel prepared for the work God has planned for them in 2024.
12	Give thanks for the many gospel opportunities Duke Street Church, Richmond , had this Christmas. Pray for repentance and faith among those who attended, and for many to come to their '321' follow-up course this month.
13	Give thanks for the 20+ long-term mission partners who have joined the UFM Worldwide family in this financial year so far. Please pray for the interviews with three more applicants this month and pray that UFM would serve its mission partners well.
14	Praise the Lord for recent growth in some of the Evangelical Fellowship of Congregational Churches' (EFCC) church revitalisations. Please pray that churches will reach out with evangelistic zeal this New Year and that the Lord would delight to save many and add to their numbers.
15	Please pray for Barry King from Grace Baptist Partnership as he lectures on 'Church planting and revitalisation' at London Seminary today (15 January).
16	Please pray for those who have signed up to study on the Crosslands Seminary course starting this month. Pray that their hearts would be prepared to learn from God's word and be shaped as faithful disciples.
17	Please pray for the ordination of Kenny Stephenson, who recently completed his course at the Reformed Theological College, to the pastorate of Limavady Reformed Presbyterian Church of Ireland (RPCI) congregation tomorrow (18 January). 20	Give thanks that Lovewise has continuing opportunities to present its 'Growing upGrowing wise' series of lessons on puberty at a primary school in Basingstoke; the next series is due to begin tomorrow (21 January). Please also pray for the Lovewise team as they begin working on an online resource bank for church youth groups on marriage, relationships, and sex. Pray that there would be a clear emphasis on biblical and biological truth throughout and that the finished product would be usable in various youth group settings.
21	At the end of this month, the present minister of Peterhead Congregational Church , James McMillan, will retire and the new minister, Dustin Black, will start. Both men will work together for a smooth handover. The congregation has much to be thankful for in the call of Dustin and in the long ministry of James. Please pray for God's hand on all of this.
22	Please join Faith in Later Life in praying for older people who find January a dark and dreary month. Pray that God will infuse their days with light and hope.

Sharing Christ Internationally reports that after the most recent video, Bible sales in secular shops in Ulaanbaatar, the capital, increased. Please pray for this multimedia ministry, that God will use it to draw people to himself.
